- + After Mass, Please Do Not Leave Anything in the Pew.

### **Welcome**

#### **Sunday Mass Guidelines**

As we come together after this long absence, we must be careful to protect our neighbors and ourselves by observing the following procedures:

- Currently, the Obligation to attend Mass is lifted. If you feel ill, are older than 64 or have health issues, you should stay home.
- The number of people at Mass is limited according to public health guidelines, currently 50% of our normal church seating capacity.
- To enter the church, you must wear a mask and use hand sanitizer as needed.
- Social distancing of six feet is required everywhere on church property, including the steps, parking lot, restrooms, etc.
- Family Members Living-In the Same House Do Not Need to Sit 6 Feet Apart.
- You must sign in so you can be contacted if someone at the Mass is later found to have COVID-19 exposure.
- Church entrances and exits are limited for the safety of all.
- Currently, the Holy Water is removed, the Collection will be taken as you enter church, the Offertory Procession is eliminated and no personal contact at the Sign of Peace.
- After Mass, the ushers will release you one pew at a time to receive Communion, and Holy Communion will only be given in the hand. Gloves are not to be worn.
- After Mass, Please Do Not Leave Anything in the Pew.
- If we all take these steps prayerfully, with hearts filled with love for God and our neighbors, we will hasten the day when we can again gather for large celebrations.
